

The 18th International Biennale of Theatre Poster - YOUNG ARTISTS COMPETITION 2023 aims to present posters promoting theatre and opera performances, concerts or related events created in 2021-2023. The Biennale exhibition will be held in November 2023 at the Wanda Siemaszkowa Theatre in Rzeszów

1.

The 18 th International Biennale of Theatre Poster – YOUNG ARTISTS COMPETITION'2023 is organized by Wanda Siemaszkowa Theatre in Rzeszów. The event is organized as part of Przestrzenie Sztuki/ Art Spaces. The program is financed by the Minister of Culture and National Heritage, implemented by the Teatralny im. Zbigniew Raszewski and the National Institute of Music and Dance.

2.

The competition is open to young artists who are under 30 years of age in August 2023. **3.**

Each participant may send any number of works.

Digital versions of the posters (A4 size, 300 dpi, JPEG) and filled in entry form should be sent by **15 October 2023** to the following address:

The digital files should be labelled with the author's name and the title/the first word of the title of the poster:

e.g.: Surname and First name_Title in English.

The pre-selection stage of the Competition will be held on **17 and 18 October 2023**. The 80 pre-selected posters will be presented on exhibition and published in the catalogue. The list of participants whose works will by qualified for the exhibition,

will be announced on the Theatre website. <u>www.teatr-rzeszow.pl</u> **on 20 Ocober 2023**. **5.**

The authors qualified for the exhibition must send their works in a print format (B1) together with a filed in entry form by **8 November 2023** to the following address:

In the clearly filled in entry form the author of the poster(s) must declare he/she has read the rules, and confirm that the enclosed posters listed in the entry form are their own work, and will grant free-of-charge use of his/her work(s) in publications connected with the 18th International Biennale of Theatre Poster – YOUNG ARTISTS COMPETITION'2023. 7.

The cost of shipping is covered by the authors. The posters should be carefully packed for shipping and the organizers cannot accept liability for any damages during transport.

The package should contain a label saying NON COMMERCIAL VALUE.

9.

Posters must be selected for the competition by the International Qualifying Jury. Awards and distinctions will be granted by the International Jury.

10.

The Jury will award authors of the most outstanding posters with the following prizes:

The First Prize The Second Prize The Third Prize Three Honorable Mentions

The winners will be informed about the prizes by e-mail.

11.

The Jury's verdict will be announced and the prizes will be handed during the exhibition opening ceremony in Rzeszów (**10 November 2023**) during the inauguration of the

61st Rzeszów Theater Meetings - Festival of Masterpieces.

12.

The Catalogue will be published on the occasion of the 18th International Biennale of Theatre Poster in Rzeszów. YOUNG ARTISTS COMPETITION'2023.

The prize winners and authors of posters qualified for the exhibition will receive 1 free copy of the catalogue and a diploma confirming their participation in the Biennale. **13.**

By sending posters to the 18th International Biennale of Theatre Poster in Rzeszów. YOUNG ARTISTS COMPETITION'2023. those entering their works confirm they agree to the terms and conditions.

The organizers do not return works entered to the Biennale.
